Honorary Degree and Order of Wilfrid Laurier University Nomination Form

Wilfrid Laurier University invites members of the university community and the general public to nominate worthy individuals for Honorary Degrees and the Order of Wilfrid Laurier University.

Deadlines

- Nominations can be received at any time, with those received prior to November 15 being eligible for the following Fall convocation, and those received prior to February 15 for the following Spring Convocation, or other convocation dates as appropriate.

Selection Process

1. Honorary degrees are awarded honoris causa, “for the sake of honour” and are intended to recognize individuals who have made outstanding contributions locally, nationally, and globally.
2. Honorary Degrees are not awarded posthumously or in absentia.
3. All individuals nominated as candidates will be considered, in strictest confidence, by the Senate Honorary Degree Committee. Recommendations of the Senate Honorary Degree Committee will be forwarded to the Senate Executive and Finance Committee for approval.
4. Names of the candidates approved by the Senate Executive and Finance Committee will be kept on a reserve list for ten years. Recipients will be selected by the President from among the approved candidates on the reserve list.
5. Due to the confidential nature of the proceedings, nominators will be contacted after consideration only if the candidate is selected to receive an honour.
