## Minimum Thresholds of Active Chairs Needed to Have an Equity Target in a Designated Group

There is a minimum number of active and approved chairs that an institution must have at the time that equity targets are confirmed by the program before targets are required for each of the designated groups. When the minimum thresholds stipulated below are met at the time of the program's equity target setting exercise, the institution will be required to have a target for that group. Note that subsequent equity target setting exercises will take place in February 2026, February 2028 etc.
